The Ho-Chunk Nation Department of Health regrets to inform the community that our department was recently notified of two individuals within our service delivery area who had tested positive for COVID-19 and now have passed away. We extend our sympathy to those individual's family members and we encourage everyone to respect the family's privacy at this most difficult time.

The Ho-Chunk Nation Department of Health has had a total of 379 community members who have tested positive for COVID-19, four people have died. Like other communities throughout the State of Wisconsin the impact of this new disease has been devastating. Just like other parts of the State we have community members recovering at home and we have community members being treated in a hospital setting. We continue to work with our local, State, and Federal partners to care for our communities.

We also continue to encourage everyone to Stay Safer at Home. This is the most important thing that we can do to prevent this illness from impacting our community. Please practice social distancing when you must go out use a mask.
